James Baxter updated everyone on the upcoming CCFCA Regional. See more details on Page 3.

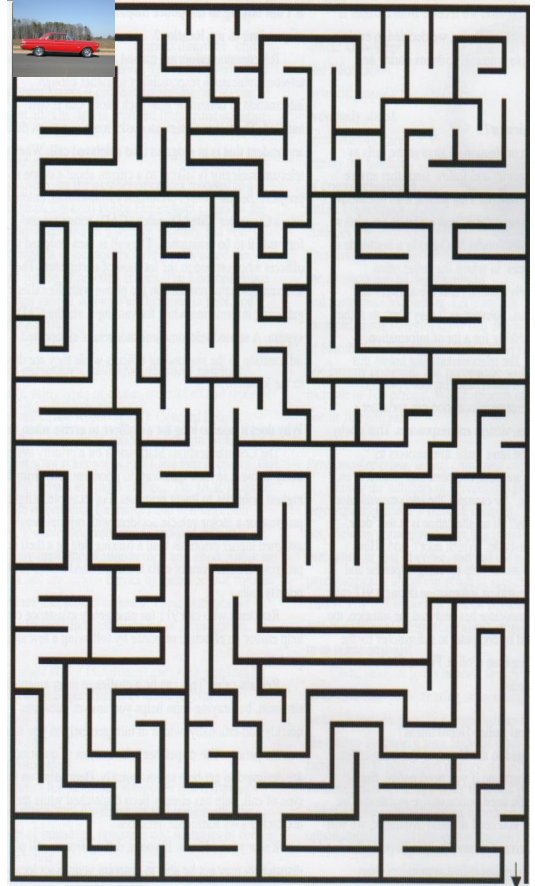

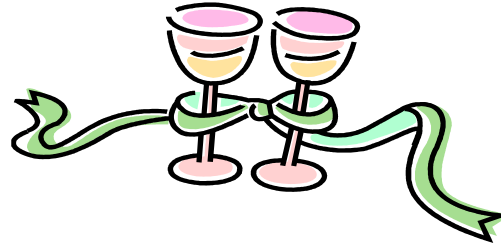

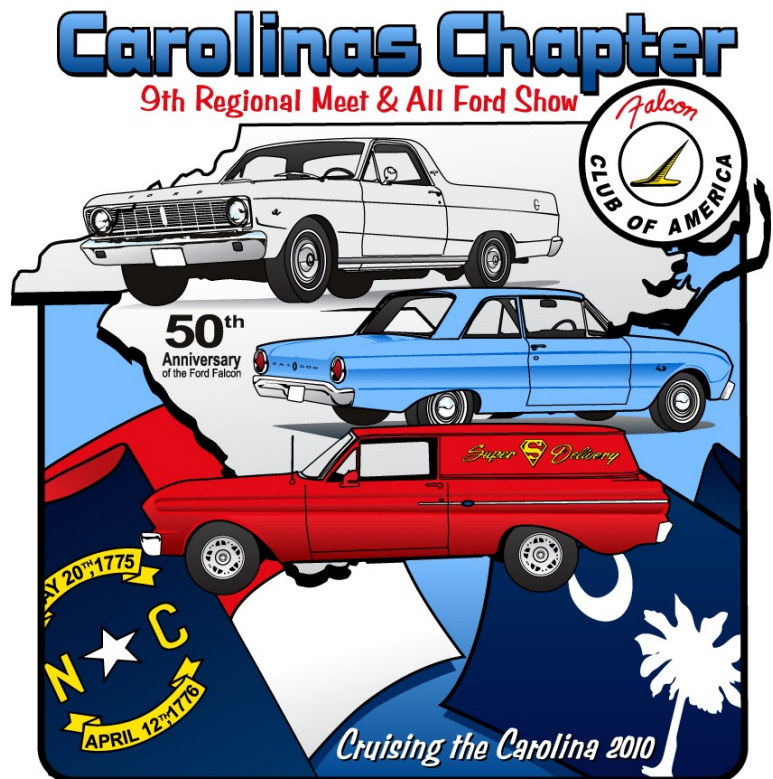
## CCFCA 9th Regional Update
